## ASQ Section 1304 Audit SIG Completes First Audit

The St. Louis Audit Special Interest Group (SIG) completed its first ISO audit in March performing a complete system audit using the ISO 13485 (medical device) standard. The audit team was composed of three auditors. Bill Freestone (Boeing) is a certified Lead Auditor and the SIG's audit coordinator that organized the audit and led the team as the team's Lead Auditor. Steve Flick (Bizmanualz) and Chris Anderson (Section Chair) participated on the audit team as auditors.

Bill was instrumental in creating the St. Louis Audit SIG. He was a founding member of the Audit SIG in Dallas, TX, and was able to bring with him a lot of the audit documentation, procedures, and information that they used in Dallas. Without Bill's dedication and efforts the St. Louis Audit SIG would not have been able to get off the ground as fast as it did.

The team spent three half days training and organizing for an ISO 13485 audit and two full days performing the audit on site at the client's facility. The client used the audit to obtain objective feedback, fulfill their requirement for conducting an Internal Audit, and obtained ISO training for some of its quality personnel. Overall it was a great experience for the Section and the client company. The auditors received audit hours towards their Lead Auditor certification and the client received a FREE audit and training. Everybody was pleased with the outcome and is looking forward to another audit. ### RECERTIFICATION JOURNAL CHECKLIST

- ✓ Support material will not be returned so only send **COPIES** of your data, **DO NOT** send originals
- ✓ Support material should be organized by Recertification category. You must fill out the page covering any category which you are claiming credit. Only submit pages for categories you are claiming, not blank pages.
- ✓ Do not submit excess credits, they will not be looked at. You may submit a few extra. Please adhere to the maximum credits allowed in each category.
- ✓ **SIGN** the application and provide both work and home phone numbers in the areas provided. **Also provide a fax number to expedite response time.**
- ✓ If **TEACHING** is part of your regular job, you cannot take credit for that activity in both Instructor and Employment Recertification categories. If teaching is not part of your job, you must submit a letter from your employer stating that it is over & above your normal function. It must state number of hours teaching.
- ✓ If you are synchronizing certifications, make sure that you have enough RUs to cover the current certification.
- ✓ When you have multiple employers in your re-certification period, a letter from each is required. Please fill out an employment form giving dates of employment, full/part time and job functions. Indicate months/years of employment and credit claimed. Job function must relate to quality.
- ✓ Professional development credits are given for seminars, short courses, conferences and workshops. (Even if these are sponsored by colleges). Only the CU or RU designated on a Certificate of Completion will be honored.
- ✓ Please note the special requirements under Electronic Media Credits and that 1 hour of viewing is 0.1 RU not 1.0.
- ✓ Preferred method of payment is Credit Card to expedite the process. Make sure to sign the Credit Card Section. If you write a check, make it payable to ASQ (this goes to National, NOT Section 1304)
